Administrative Council Highlights – January 7, 2025

The Ad Council met by Zoom conference on Tuesday, January 7, 2025 with five people present. The following items were discussed:

- **Nurture, Outreach and Witness (NOW).** The women will meet for lunch on January 11 at Espana's Restaurant. The VBS dates will be June 23 through 27. A planning meeting will be held right after church and lunch on January 19, and everyone in the church is invited.
- **Trustees.** There is a group that wants to rent a classroom three days a week, on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday from 5:00PM to 6:30PM, and the Trustees are determining the price. Russ has replaced the irrigation lines outside of the hall. Ivoni reported that there was a problem with one of the sprinkler lines running non-stop, but Kevin was taking care of it during the meeting. Pastor Ivoni mentioned that all was good at the parsonage. The Trustees will meet in person on January 14 at 6:00PM to elect their officers.
- **United Women in Faith.** Laura Scott reported that the women helped a family in need at Christmas. Melissa was in charge of the women providing about 50 blankets to the rest home. All women are invited to the January 11 lunch at Espana's starting at 1:00PM. Lori will be leading a Valentines Card making craft at the February meeting
- **Staff-Parish Relations Committee.** Susan encouraged all, including youth, to attend the planning meeting on January 19 after church. Lunch will be provided.

- **Financial Report.** Gregg gave a breakdown of total income for 2024, stating that the categories of income used to compute our 10% tithe/apportionment obligation totaled \$148,262, so our 10% goal was \$14,826. Our usual sources for apportionments are special offerings for Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas, scrip proceeds, and the Fall Festival. Those were about \$3,000 than was needed, so we were able to pay our Apportionments in full, and \$3,000 was transferred into the General Fund.

The two checking accounts ended the year with healthy balances, mainly due to a generous one-time payment from the Wilma Ditter estate, and \$25,000 from two grants from the District and Conference. The giving from our congregation was \$22,000 less than in 2023, and the number of giving families dropped to 36.

- **Parish Care.** Prayers were requested for Don and Carley, Kimery, Guadalupe, Gregg, Donna Morris, and Karen and Dan.
- **Pastor's Report.** Pastor Ivoni mentioned that she wants to hold a "Bring a Friend Sunday" and start a Bible Study and/or Bible Reading classes in 2025.
